

14 Pin to 16 Pin OBD 2 Diagnostic Adapter

Cable for Mercedes Benz Sprinter



Description:

This adapter allows the use of standard compatible obd2 Diagnostic equipment to connect with the 14 pin round DLC (data link connector) used in the Mercedes Sprinter range of commercial vehicles.

Also used on the Volkswagen LT range of commercial vehicles.

Cable is fitted with the 14 pin Mercedes Sprinter/VW LT Diagnostic connector and 14 pin OBD2 female connector.

Sprinter & LT 14 pin Breakout Box or MB Sprinter Breakout Box Special breakout box which enables you to access all pins on a 14 pin Mercedes Benz Sprinter or Volkswagen LT connector via 4mm female banana sockets. Some cars use a lot of different K-lines for it's different systems like engine ECU, ABS, etc. this is needed for most scantools if you want to access all the systems just by plugging the K-line into the right socket of the system (Examples of such cars are Opel or Mercedes Benz)

Features:

Used to connect compatible diagnostic tools with OBD2 interface on a 14Pin socket Mercedes Benz car.

Works on all Mercedes Benz vehicles with a 14Pin female interface.

Connector: Benz 14Pins male connector; OBDII 16pins female connector.
